

GEMÜ scholarship at Heilbronn University

Call for applications for the summer semester 2026

Purpose of the scholarship

To this end, GEMÜ is offering two scholarships through the Fritz Müller Foundation. The scholarship will give you the opportunity to get to know the company and gain an insight into its diverse range of activities.

Amount and duration of the scholarship

GEMÜ is offering two scholarships for the 2026 summer semester. Funding will begin on March 1, 2026, and will be granted for one semester. The scholarship amounts to €300 per month. Depending on the student's academic progress, there is an option to extend the scholarship.

Application period

Applications for scholarships will be accepted between **November 24, 2025 to December 31, 2025**.

Applications will not be considered in the selection process if:

- received before the start or after the end of the deadline
- contain incomplete documents

Application requirements

- Enrollment in one of the following degree programs (bachelor's and master's degrees):
 - o Industrial Engineering
 - o Production and Process Management/Technical Management
 - o or other technical degree program
- Students from the **first semester onwards**
- **No internship semester or thesis in cooperation with a company** during the summer semester 2026
- You have a grade point average of at least 2.5
- You feel connected to your home region

Possible further agreements

In addition to financial support, GEMÜ offers the following additional options:

- Employment for internships, working student positions, vacation jobs
- Preparation of final theses
- Further individual offers in consultation with GEMÜ

These offers are voluntary on the part of the company. The company is therefore under no obligation to offer them.

Application documents

To apply for the scholarship, please submit the following application documents by **December 31, 2025**, by email to the scholarship office (stipendienstelle@hs-heilbronn.de) at Heilbronn University:

- Completely filled out and signed application form
- Signed application agreement
- Letter of motivation (max. 1 DIN A4 page)
- Tabular resume with date and signature
- Current, complete transcript of grades
- Certificate of enrollment for the summer semester 2026, if not already available for the winter semester 2025/2026
- If available, certificates from relevant internships, vocational training, professional activities

Unfortunately, incomplete applications or applications received after the application deadline cannot be considered in the selection process.

If the application documents are not written in German or English, an officially certified translation into German must be included.

Application process

- First, please fill out the [application form](#) and the [application agreement](#) and send them with all other required documents by email to **stipendienstelle@hs-heilbronn.de**
- If you are shortlisted, you will be invited to a personal interview with the company
- You will likely be informed about an invitation to the interview in July
- The interviews themselves will then take place in mid January/early February 2026, by arrangement. Please make a note of this period in advance.

All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application. Please refrain from inquiring about the status of your application.
