

# HHN Education for Ukrainian Future

## Scholarship program



Heilbronn University uses funds from the DAAD scholarship program "Future Ukraine" to support the academic education of Ukrainian students who had to leave their home country due to the war and are pursuing a degree in Germany.

The aim of the program is to support Ukraine by making a long-term and sustainable contribution to the qualification of Ukrainian students at Heilbronn University.

## CONTENT OF THE GRANT

- Grant amount: 931,00€ monthly
- Start of funding: 01.03.2024
- Duration of funding: max. until 31.12.2024.

As a scholarship holder of the HHN Education for Ukraine scholarship, you will have the opportunity to participate in an extensive social program in addition to the financial support:

- Regular meetings with the other scholars
- Workshops on intercultural skills
- Networking with other scholars
- Excursions, e.g. to the Mercedes-Benz Museum Stuttgart
- Individual support







## APPLICATION

### *Eligible are students who*

- are enrolled in a Bachelor's or Master's degree program at Heilbronn University in the summer semester 2024,
- have been in Ukraine until 24.02.2022, and
- hold Ukrainian citizenship OR are third-country nationals or stateless persons enjoying international protection in Ukraine.

### *Application documents*

- Letter of motivation in German or English (max. 2 DIN A4 pages)
- Curriculum vitae in German or English
- diploma of the last acquired educational degree (e.g. bachelor's degree or university entrance qualification) with final grade

### *Application deadline*

The application deadline is **11.02.2024**.
