



Information on applying for the Scholarship "Engineering studies with world market leaders" at Heilbronn University, Reinhold-Würth-Hochschule, Künzelsau Campus

The scholarship "Engineering studies with world market leaders" at Heilbronn University, Reinhold-Würth-Hochschule Künzelsau Campus is aimed at first-year students in the following degree programmes at the Faculty of Engineering and Business: B.Sc. in Automation Technology and Electrical Engineering, B.Sc. in Electrical Engineering, B.Eng. Industrial Engineering and Management and B.Eng. Energy System Engineering and Management (English taught).

The scholarship programme is funded by private sponsors; the monthly funding amounts to EUR 500 as well as an electronic device (i.e. tablet) for the start of studies. The total duration of the funding is two semesters, provided that the scholarship holders successfully take part in a performance review at the end of the first semester as well as in the accompanying programme.

Application requirements

Applications are open to first-year students on the B.Sc. Automation Technology and Electrical Mechanical Engineering, B.Sc. Electrical Engineering, B.Eng. Industrial Engineering and B.Eng. Energy System Engineering and Management.

Students who are enrolled in one of the above-mentioned degree programmes at Heilbronn University, Reinhold-Würth-Hochschule Künzelsau Campus and were not enrolled at Heilbronn University in the previous semester are eligible for funding.





Application procedure

It is possible to apply for a scholarship to study engineering with world market leaders during a fixed application period for the winter and summer semesters. The application period for the scholarship is announced on the Heilbronn University scholarship website: https://www.hs-heilbronn.de/stipendien

For application documents that are not in English or German, an officially certified translation into German must be enclosed.

Mandatory documents

- Signed application form for a scholarship in the "Technology studies with the world market leaders" programme
- Certificate of higher education entrance qualification (HZB), for foreign students a translation that can be transferred to the German system and converted into the German grading system (e.g. the certificate recognition from the Studienkolleg Konstanz; in individual cases, recognition from uniassist can also be accepted if this is already available)
- Other certificates that document your technical interest in particular (e.g. training certificates)
- Curriculum vitae in tabular form
- Letter of motivation: We would like to find out who you are in a one-page letter of motivation. Tell us about yourself, your career, what has shaped you and what your professional goals are. You can use the following questions as a guide:
 - ➤ Who are you and why did you choose this degree programme? What ou are interested in technology?
 - ➤ What professional goals are you pursuing with the degree programme? What are you doing apart from your studies, are you perhaps involved in an association, voluntary work or similar?





- ➤ What characterises you as a person, what hobbies do you have?
- > Who or what has influenced you?

Selection procedure

Scholarship holders are selected by a scholarship selection committee at Heilbronn University.

The main selection criterion is the average grade of the university entrance qualification. In addition, technical interest, previous technical knowledge, hobbies, etc. can be taken into account, see above.

Acceptances and cancellations

Scholarship applicants will be informed in writing of their acceptance or rejection no later than two weeks after the application deadline for the scholarship. Please refrain from enquiring about the status of your application.

The funding amount is paid out monthly and retroactively on 1 September and 1 March of the respective funding period by the Förderkreis der Hochschule Heilbronn e. V. You will receive the electronic device (e.g. tablet) in person at the start of the semester at the Künzelsau campus.

Accompanying programme

Active participation in an accompanying programme is a prerequisite for receiving a scholarship. The aim of the accompanying programme is for the scholarship holders to get involved in joint activities at the Künzelsau campus in order to strengthen the social community and networking between students. Further goals are to support the recruitment of new students and to establish contacts with Hohenlohe companies (company visits, internships, etc.) The accompanying programme is published within the first 3 weeks of each semester.
