› APPLICATION DEADLINE

Winter semester

1st June for the following winter semester
(starting in September)

› ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- › University entrance qualification from your country validated by HTWG-Konstanz (Studienkolleg) or VDP-uni-assist
- › In case of indirect university access (Access to Studienkolleg) applicants are required to submit aptitude test result (e.g. SAT/TestAS/ITB)
- › German level A1: Goethe certificate or Onset result, not older than 6 Months
- › Additional APS certificate for applicants from certain countries (China, India, Vietnam)
- › English level B2: TOEFL min. 550-paper, 213-computer based (TOEFL Code for HHN: 2751) or IELTS min. 6.0 overall score

› ACCESS² PREPARATION YEAR COURSE CONTENT

- › German language preparation: Intensive german courses (2-3 time/week. Aim at achieving B2 CERF)
- › Subject related preparation: attending 5-25 ECTS subject-related courses per semester in Engineering, Business or Computer Science

› DURATION & COSTS

- › Duration: 2 semesters, free of charge
- › Transfer of ECTS credits to your subsequent Bachelor's degree programme at HHN upon request

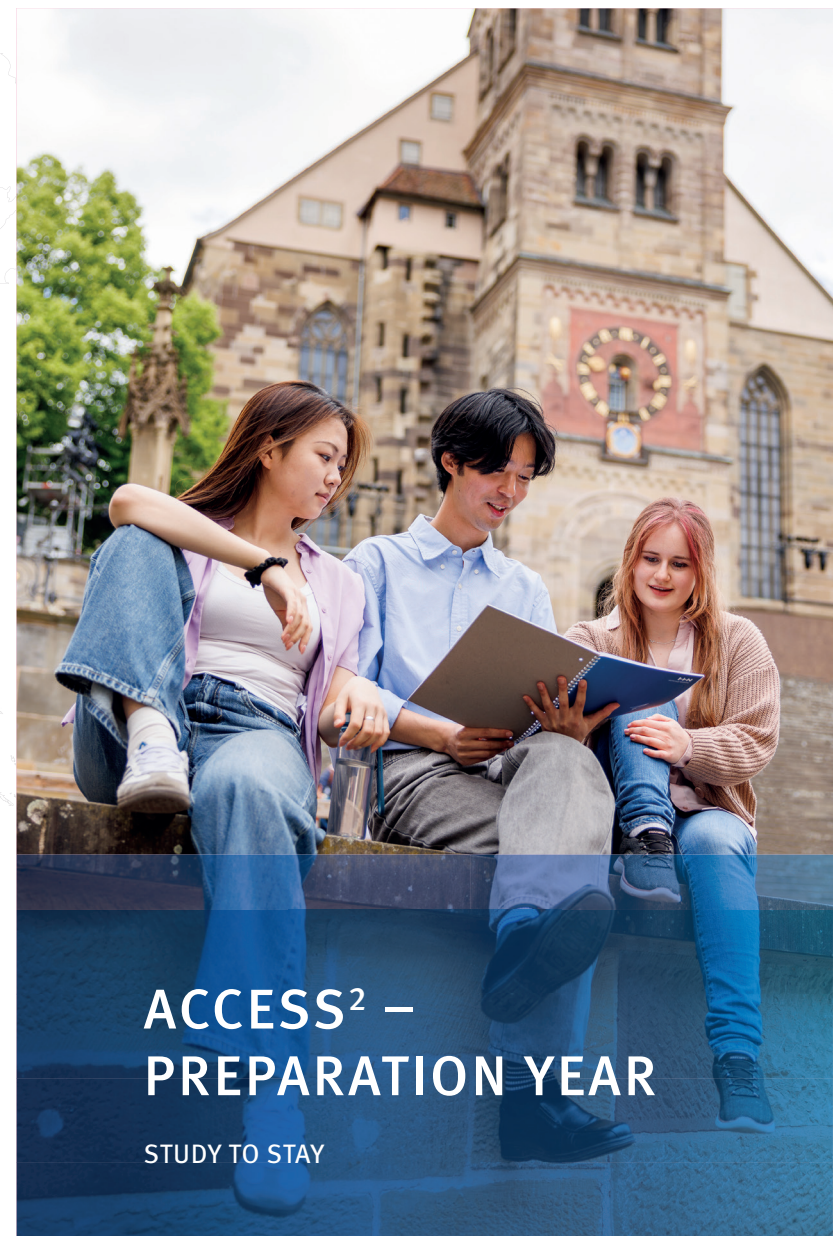
