Call for applications for the winter semester 2026/2027

About XL2

XL2 would like to support students at Heilbronn University starting in the **2026/2027 winter semester**. To this end, the company is offering **one scholarship**.

The scholarship will not only provide you with financial support from XL2, but also give you exclusive insights into the company and its diverse fields of activity. In addition, further agreements such as internships, working student positions, or the preparation of final theses can be concluded between you and the sponsor. There is also the possibility of direct entry into the company after graduation.

Amount and duration of the scholarship

The scholarship amount is €300 per month.

Funding will begin on September 1, 2026, and will initially be granted for two semesters.

Application period

Applications for the scholarship will be accepted from **June 1, 2026, to June 30, 2026**.

Applications will not be considered in the selection process if:

- received before the start or after the end of the deadline
- contain incomplete documents

Application requirements

- Enrollment in one of the following degree programs (bachelor's and master's):
 - o Applied Computer Science
 - o Software Engineering
 - o Business Informatics
- You have a grade point average of at least 2.5
- You are in the winter semester of 2026/2027 and are at least in your **third bachelor's semester** or at least in your **first master's semester**

Possible further agreements

In addition to financial support, XL2 offers the following additional options:

- Individual support from a mentor during the scholarship period
- Participation in networking events
- Employment for internships, working student positions, and thesis writing
- Opportunity for direct entry after graduation
- Further offers are possible in consultation with the company

These offers are voluntary on the part of the company. The company is therefore under no obligation to offer them.

Application documents

To apply for the scholarship, please submit the following application documents by email to the Scholarship Office at Heilbronn University (stipendienstelle@hs-heilbronn.de) between **June 1, 2026, and June 30, 2026**:

- Completed and signed [application agreement](#)
- Letter of motivation (max. one DIN A4 page)
- Tabular curriculum vitae
- Current, complete transcript of records
- Certificate of enrollment for the winter semester 2026/2027 (if not yet available, then for the summer semester 2026)
- University entrance qualification or bachelor's degree certificate
- If available, certificates of relevant internships, vocational training, professional experience, etc.

If the application documents are not written in German or English, an officially certified translation into German must be included.

Application process

- First, please fill out the application agreement and submit it with all other required documents in **one PDF file** by email to **stipendienstelle@hs-heilbronn.de**
- If you are shortlisted, you will be invited to a personal interview with the company.
- You will likely be notified of an invitation to an interview by mid-July 2026.
- The interviews themselves will then take place in July/August 2026, as agreed.
Please make a note of this period in your calendar.

All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application. Please refrain from inquiring about the status of your application.
