Amount and duration of the scholarship

Funding will begin on September 1, 2026, and will be granted for two semesters. The scholarship amounts to €300 per month. Depending on the student's academic progress, there is an option to extend the scholarship.

Application period

Applications for scholarships will be accepted between **June 1–30, 2026**.

Applications will not be considered in the selection process if:

- received before the start or after the end of the deadline
- contain incomplete documents

Application requirements

- Enrollment in one of the following degree programs (bachelor's and master's degrees):
 - o Industrial Engineering
 - o Production and Process Management/Technical Management
 - o or other technical degree program
- Applications now also open to **first-semester students**
- No internship semester or thesis in cooperation with a company during the winter semester
- You have a grade point average of at least 2.5
- You feel connected to your home region

Possible further agreements

In addition to financial support, GEMÜ offers the following additional options:

- Employment for internships, working student positions, vacation jobs
- Preparation of final theses
- Further individual offers in consultation with GEMÜ

Application documents

To apply for the scholarship, please submit the following application documents by email to the Scholarship Office at Heilbronn University (stipendienstelle@hs-heilbronn.de) between **June 1, 2026, and June 30, 2026**:

- Completely filled out and signed [application agreement](#)
- Letter of motivation (max. 1 DIN A4 page)
- Tabular resume with date and signature
- Current, complete transcript of records
- Certificate of enrollment for the winter semester 2026/2027, if not already available for the summer semester 2026
- If available, certificates from relevant internships, vocational training, professional activities

If the application documents are not written in German or English, an officially certified translation into German must be included.

Application process

- First, please fill out the application agreement and submit it with all other required documents in **one PDF file** by email to **stipendienstelle@hs-heilbronn.de**
- If you are shortlisted, you will be invited to a personal interview with the company.
- You will likely be informed about an invitation to the interview by mid July 2026.
- The interviews themselves will then take place in July/August 2026, by arrangement. Please make a note of this period in advance.

All applicants will be notified in writing of the outcome of their application. Please refrain from inquiring about the status of your application.
